Pathways *Forward* is a Supports Coordination Organization (SCO) for the Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) serving:

- Children & adults with **intellectual disabilities and/or autism**
- Young children (under age 9) with **developmental delays**
- Children & young adults (birth - age 21) with **medically complex conditions**

WHAT WE DO

Our Supports Coordinators (SCs) help individuals and families by:

- **Planning** for and monitoring of services
- **Locating** and coordinating community resources
- **Navigating** complex systems to access both formal and informal supports

THINGS TO KNOW

PUNS (Priority of Urgency of Need for Services)

This assessment is used to document the type and the urgency of your unmet service needs. This is the "waiting list" for waiver funding.

Individual Monitoring

Individuals with an SC will update their **Individual Support Plan (ISP)** at least twice a year. Frequency of face-to-face contact depends on individual needs and preferences.

Those with certain funding, like **waivers**, may require more frequent check-ins. The individual's SC will explain why regular monitoring and eligibility reviews matter - and why participation in these meetings is important.

During visits, the SC will ensure services match the ISP and monitor the individual's **health, safety, and satisfaction.**
